I know that some people will disagree with some points but I also think there are some areas where we should strongly agree after seeing how a situation or exercise develops. All our communications start with the simplest radio systems, even a person with a handheld radio and a notepad has a place in emergency communications. But we can have so much more to offer, if there is a need. Our skills are in linking all these different systems together HF and VHF or voice and data into one network. I experience some people who think that HF does not have a role, or that we should be moving to doing everything using WiFi or non-amateur networks.

I believe this exercise shows everything has a place, when we have a need. Some of you will remember though the RAYNET Technology Survey I presented at Friedrichshafen which showed some groups in the UK had built a WiFi capability, then ~25% never used it regularly enough to build confidence that it would work when needed...
